What it covers:

Cycle 360's Trade-In Scheme covers the following bicycles;

- Road, Gravel and TT bikes
 - Less than 5 years old with an original selling price of more than £2,000
- E-bikes
 - Less than 3 years old and less than 1000 miles ridden with an original selling price of more than £2,500.
- Road, Gravel and TT framesets
 - Less than 5 years old with an original selling price of more than £1,000
- Wheelsets
 - Less than 5 years old with an original selling price of more than £500

What it doesn't currently cover:

- Mountain Bikes
- Hybrid bikes
- BMX bikes
- Tandem bikes
- Recumbent bikes
- Trikes bikes
- Kids Bikes
- Fat bikes
- Folding bikes
- Tubular Wheels



Does my bike have to be in perfect condition to get a quote?

No, but defects will be taken into consideration on the overall value of your bike. It helps to bring your bike in as clean and ready to go as possible, so the best possible quote can be obtained.

All quotes are subject to an assessment by a Cycle 360 mechanic. We can of course clean and service your bikes prior to your quote at our standard rate.

For a bike to be considered for trade in, it must be deemed to be above 8/10 condition.

How is my bike priced?

The following factors are considered before making an offer for a bike:

- Price when new
- Age and model year
- Demand & supply of make and model
- Condition of bike and usage.
- Components with any wear and tear will be factored into the price.
- Prices from all online marketplaces, retailers, shops, direct distributors for most up to date pricing
 are factored in. The second-hand value will be directly related to what the bike can be bought for
 new.

Note: Even if the bike fits within these parameters, there is no guarantee we can make an offer for trade in. This is usually due to market conditions.
